Dear Parents

I am writing to let you know that unfortunately we are unable to accommodate any children on the 1st June including our vulnerable children and those children of critical workers. I am sorry to be writing this, but in truth it was an oversight on my part.

During the last couple of weeks all primary headteachers have been bombarded with additional guidance by the government, which has necessitated us writing numerous risk assessments, understanding and interpreting social distancing information, implementing hygiene instructions, and buying additional supplies including signage, to name just a few things. The inset day has been set aside to prepare eighteen classes, including moving furniture, reducing non-essential resources, as well as having virtual meetings with all staff (on site) in order to disseminate all the procedures and policies that we are having to adopt during this time.

We have kept the school open every day since the lockdown began and it is with great reluctance that I am now having to close it for one day. I apologise for the short notice, and sincerely hope that it will not cause too much inconvenience.
