
An amazing 100% agree to their children making good progress.


98% agree that their child enjoys school. My children love coming to Owlsmoor.' Our daughter enjoys school and is getting on well.'



A very good result of 98.67%, showing that the staff realise that the child's well being is as important as their education.






100% agree that Owlsmoor helps develop skills.

I am very pleased with the school and all it does for my son and his development. We live in Bracknell but happily drive to and from Owlsmoor as he and we are so happy with the school.'




98% agree that there is a good standard of behaviour at this school.




90% agree to the question of bullying and there is a high % for no response (6.67%), but many of the comments received spoke of not coming across it so therefore unable to comment either way.






A good responses at 96% Communication is always tricky to get correct, especially getting a good balance with all the new technological ways of communicating available to us today.


'The communication to parents could be a lot better. I often find a lot of questions asked on facebook that parents are wondering.'
